

HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

School staff will do all they can to:

- provide a safe and secure environment where social, emotional, physical and intellectual knowledge and skills are encouraged and developed.
- provide a balanced curriculum and personalised programmes where appropriate to meet individual needs.
- foster an ethos where all positive developments and contributions are valued and praised and inappropriate or unacceptable behaviours are understood and addressed.
- contact parents/ carers if there is a concern with health, learning, behaviour or happiness.
- encourage a multi-professional approach to support each child.
- use a home/school book where necessary to foster two-way communication to support each child.
- keep families informed about school news, initiatives and activities through letters, special events notices, via the website, text service.
- arrange regular open evenings, Annual Review meetings and opportunities for parents and carers to discuss their child's progress and be involved in school life.

Parent/ Carers will do all they can to:

- see that their child attends school regularly and, when absence is necessary, contact school with the reason for absence. Update change of address/ telephone number/ medication.
- let the school know of concerns or problems that might affect their child's work, behaviour, or circumstances.
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for e-safety.
- work in partnership with the school, using a home/school book or other means of communication and support homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- regularly attend open evenings and Reviews of their child's progress and needs.
- be involved with the school and their child's life there.
