- Better Reading Support Partners, a Reading Action programme, delivered to 2 pupils (£169.76 per pupil). Wave 3 Reading Action Programme delivered to 2 further pupils (£333.76 per pupil). Additional cover costs: £220
- Class teacher of 5<sup>th</sup> pupil will attend an Intensive Interaction course delivered later in the year (£260 course + travel). Additional sensory resources will be purchased to support child in developing pre-literacy and pre-numeracy skills, following consultation with speech and language therapist (£240)
- 1st Class@Number, a Maths Action programme, delivered to 2 pupils (£188.96 per pupil)
- Numbers and Patterns Maths Action programme + resources, to be prepared by Maths lead (£330), to be delivered by TA.
- 1:1 Maths extension support for pupil (£330)

## Pupil 1

Increased ability to sound out words and use pictures within the story for clues of what the words may be. Increased concentration skills at times, despite emotional barriers to learning.

#### Pupil 2

Increased ability to sound out words. Excellent development in interpreting and explaining what was happening in the picture books.

## Pupil 3

Made progress with interpreting and in speaking about what was happening within pictures. Showing concentration skills for up to 10 minutes at a time.

## Pupil 4

Recent data input for this pupil with complex barriers to learning- academic, physical, communication showed progress from P3(ii)c to P3(ii)b for Shape, Shape, Measure and from P3(ii)c to P3(ii)a for Writing following staff training in delivering a specialist curriculum to pupils with these early skills.
